

# **St Charles Opening New Pharmacy**

St Charles Health System is opening a pilot community pharmacy in Madras in the late Spring, helping to fill a critical health need and improving access to prescription medication. Many community organizations came together through funding and support, including Central Oregon Health Council, which provided \$460,000 in funding. The new pharmacy will be located at the site of the former Hometown Drug.

Once opened, the pharmacy will fill prescriptions, in store and via drive-up window, and provide immunizations, medication management, injections for long-term care needs and retails sales for over-the-counter medicine and durable medical equipment.

### Shaniko & Transportation (part 2)

From the time gold was discovered in Canyon City, OR in 1862, as was the Homestead act passed by Congress that year, freight and stage travel exploded from The Dalles and into the interiors of Eastern Oregon (all OR east of the Cascades). Once Shaniko had a railhead in 1900, freight and passengers were still moving further into those areas on wagon wheels. Shaniko became a hub for shipping which brought the commodities of the interior to a closer location, bringing a highway of business and human travel.


